Lily was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia on September 17, 2021. She is currently receiving treatment at Children's hospital which requires her to remain inpatient for 3-4 weeks each cycle. When she is able to come home, she enjoys spending time with her little sister, Ava, and playing with her dog. Lily is such a strong little girl who has faced this diagnosis with such a positive attitude.

The hope is that Lily's last treatment will end late March- early April. If all scans come back with no evidence of disease, Lily will get to come home for good. Lily was only able to attend kindergarten for one month prior to her diagnosis. The hope is that her immune system will recover within 3-6 months, so that she is finally able to attend in person school next year as a 1st grader.
