Ky-Mani was born with a congenital heart disease called Ebstein's Anomaly. Last year at 15-years-old he underwent open heart surgery. Unfortunately, it was not successful, and four days later he underwent a second surgery. Months later he found out he was at Stage 4 heart failure. He's now facing another open heart surgery, and electrical ablation at Mayo Clinic. Ky-Mani has not been able to attend his Sophomore year at Ravenna due to a weakened immune system and health issues. Due to state laws, insurance has denied covering costs. Ky-Mani will undergo an open heart surgery again in March, with high hopes that his surgeon at Mayo, that specializes in Ky-Mani's specific condition, will have a successful surgery!
